- **Lorne Fraser Educational Bursary**
Bursaries of \$700 for individuals in BC currently enrolled or applying for post-secondary education or job training
- **Lorne Fraser Scholarship for Mental Health Promotion**
Scholarships of \$1,000 or \$2,000 for BC university or college students pursuing a career related to mental health
- **Mental Health Fine Arts Bursary (FAB) Award**
One \$1000 bursary for a student enrolled or accepted to a post-secondary program in the field of fine art
- **Indigenous Mental Health Fine Arts Bursary (FAB) Award**
One \$1000 bursary for an Indigenous student who is pursuing fine arts at Emily Carr University of Art and Design
